

RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS

E. WAYNE GILLES TR. ET AL

TO

TERRACE VIEW RESORT

WHEREAS, E. Wayne Gilley, Trustee, Charles O. Hon, Jr., and Nelle M. Hon, Trustees, and C. O. Hon and wife, Mary E. Hon, are the owners of a forty (40) acre, more or less, tract at the extreme northeast corner of Rhea County, Tennessee, and which is the eastern portion of a tract conveyed to said owners by deed recorded in Book 90, page 228-229, of the Register's Office of said County and which part of said tract is to be known in the future as "Terrace View Resort" and

WHEREAS, said owners desire to develop a subdivision of quality and do, therefore, impose the following restrictions which constitute real covenants running with the land and binding upon anyone who may come into ownership of any lot whether by purchase, devise, descent or successor, to take effect as of the date of sale to purchasers of lots in said subdivision and will be contained in the deeds conveying the lots;

(1) To use the lots for private residence purposes only,

(2) Not to construct or maintain or cause or suffer to be constructed or maintained on each lot any building with appurtenant outbuilding other than a single family dwelling containing not less than nine hundred (900) square feet of floor space including porch or attached garage. Construction of such building must be completed within six (6) months of its beginning. No house trailers are allowed.

(3) To construct for use with dwellings, septic tanks for the disposal of sewage, in accordance with the standards prescribed by the State and County public health officials.

(4) Not to construct or maintain on the lots any building located nearer than fifteen (15) feet from any side line or nearer than twenty-five (25) feet from the margin of the right of way of any road; however, if the ownership of two adjoining lots is vested on one party, said party may construct on the one boundary line,

(4) Not to construct or maintain on the lots any building located nearer than fifteen (15) feet from any side line or nearer than twenty-five (25) feet from the margin.

(5) Not to use ~~any~~ of said lots as a dumping ground for rubbish, trash, garbage or other waste; to keep all waste in sanitary containers and all incinerators and other equipment for the storage and disposal of waste in a clean and sanitary condition.

Should any one or more of the foregoing stipulations be violated at any time by the owner of any lot, or anyone deriving title or rights from or through them, then they or either of them shall be subject\* to be enjoined by proper process from violating this contract and shall be liable for costs and reasonable attorney's fees incident to such injunction proceedings which costs and attorney's fees are as agreed upon as liquidated damages, and shall be liable for such other and additional damages as may accrue. \* and liable at the suit of the grantors or by the then constituted public authorities
